YOUNG AFCEAN COMMITTEE



ARTICLE I MEMBERSHIP

Section 1. Membership in the Young AFCEAN Committee shall be open to all Tidewater Chapter persons 40 years and younger, without discrimination, who are interested in furthering the objectives of the Chapter and the International Association as set forth in its By-Laws.

Section 2. Membership Dues: Membership dues shall conform with the dues as outlined in the International By-Laws. Additional funds for committee activities may be raised, if necessary, under the umbrella of the local Chapter by appropriate means.

ARTICLE II YAC COMMITTEE STRUCTURE

The Young AFCEAN Committee, under the general supervision of the Director of Membership Services, shall be responsible for the coordination of programs, which will insure the increase of membership of Young AFCEANs, members who will develop and improve the effectiveness of the goal of AFCEA. The Committee will launch programs, which will attract and maintain such members.

There are four basic committee roles in a YAC organization, but these can be expanded as the organization grows.

Section 1. The YAC President shall have general supervision of the affairs of the Young AFCEAN Council and shall perform the duties usual to that office. The YAC President shall be a member of the Board of Directors. The YAC President shall attend all meetings of the Chapter, the Executive Committee, and the Board of Directors.

Section 2. The YAC Vice President shall arrange all Young AFCEAN programs associated with the Chapter. The YAC VP/P shall establish agendas and be responsible for all efforts within the YAC council. The YAC VP shall assume the duties of the YAC President during the YAC President's absence.

Section 3. The YAC Executive Chair shall record and maintain minutes of all YAC meetings. The Executive Chairs will distribute copies to members of the YAC and Executive Committee. The Executive Chair shall attend to all general correspondence under the direction of the YAC President or Executive Committee, shall keep a roll of membership including the address of each member, shall prepare all reports required, and shall perform other duties that pertain to the office. In addition, the Executive Chair will assist the Chapter Secretary in luncheon meeting preparation.

Section 4. The YAC Committee Chair shall arrange YAC support and coordinate with all committees created by the organization to ensure there adequate representation from YAC members and will be responsible for their performance and organization. The YAC Committee Chair shall brief the updates of the committees at each chapter meeting and request volunteers for each committee.

Section 5. Other positions such as Treasurer, Membership, and Education should be considered as needed.

ARTICLE III MEETINGS

Section 1. The YAC Committee shall hold monthly meetings separate from the general membership meetings, the time and place to be designated by the YAC Committee. The meetings shall be devoted to discussions of career and leadership development, YAC events, and how the Chapter's Young AFCEANs can improve participation in Chapter events and further the goals of the organization. The events shall be focused around scientific, industrial, civilian government, educational, and military matters and other subjects as may be deemed desirable by the Committee.

Section 2. At any meeting of the YAC Committee, no fewer than one-third of the members of the Committee shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of the business of the Committee. Any business transacted, unless otherwise specified in these Bylaws, shall be valid, providing it is affirmatively passed upon by a majority of those present. Members present at a Committee meeting may continue to do business until adjournment, notwithstanding the withdrawal of enough members to have less than a quorum.

Section 3. Notice of meetings will be provided via electronic mail to the Chapter's YAC members and guests.

ARTICLE IV FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS

Financial obligations shall not be incurred by the YAC on behalf of the Chapter. The YAC President shall make proposals relating to expenditures to the BOD for approval.

ARTICLE V AMENDMENTS

Section 1. Amendments to this document may be proposed by a majority vote of the YAC Committee members and approved by the Chapter Board of Directors or the Executive Committee or upon petition addressed to the President and signed by not less than five percent of the total number of full members. The BOD or Executive Committee must approve all amendments to the By-Laws before submission to the YAC membership.

Section 2. Proposed amendments shall be submitted to the entire active full membership not less than one month before they are voted upon at a regular meeting, or may be included in the notice of such meeting.

Section 3. Amendments that have been adopted by a majority of the members voting upon them at a regular meeting shall become effective immediately; unless otherwise provided for.
